RECEIVING: Entries for Arts and Crafts will be accepted in Duval Hall “B”, on Sunday, November 1, 2026, from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. and Monday, November 2, 2026, from 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. **No entries will be accepted for judging after the cut-off time!** Entry tags will be available at check in.

Entry fees are not required for Arts and Crafts entries. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know the General Rules and Regulations as well as the Special Rules that govern the individual competitions entered. Please check carefully the division(s) in which you are interested.

Articles must be the original work of the exhibitor, finished within the past two years, and not previously exhibited at the Greater Jacksonville Agricultural Fair.

***Exhibitors may enter no more than three (3) items per category and a limit of 10 items per division. ***

Names must not be visible on any article.

Articles of excessive size or soiled articles will not be accepted. Framed entries, plaques, mobiles, etc., must be equipped with a hanging wire of sufficient strength to support the article.

Articles received will be under the control and jurisdiction of The Greater Jacksonville Agricultural Fair Association. Every possible care will be taken to prevent damage, but in no case will the Fair Association be responsible for any damage or loss that may occur.

The chairperson reserves the right to refuse any article. Articles will be judged and ribbons placed before the fair opens.

Premium money will be paid on the basis of the judges' records, not by the ribbon that may be attached to the article. Honorable Mention Awards earn no cash premiums. Awards are limited to 3 per category and 10 items per division.

RELEASE: Arts & Crafts articles must be picked up Sunday, November 15, 2026, from 7:00 p.m. until 8:30 p.m. and Monday, November 16, 2026 from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon. Your exhibitor claim check will allow entrance. A guard will instruct you where to park for pick-up and loading only; no exceptions. Articles not claimed during these hours will become the property of the Greater Jacksonville Agricultural Fair Association.
